Today Bishop works out of her 1910 Victorian studio in San Antonio, TX, shows in galleries and art shows, gives workshops, and continues designing custom fabrics for home furnishings.

The San Antonio based artist has served as an instructor at the Southwest School of Art and Craft and San Antonio College. Kersey's earthenware pottery is made using the potter's wheel to form the vessels. At the leather-hard stage the pots are decorated with draw tools and self-designed sprig molds. Each pot is individually created and is one-of-a-kind. All of Kersey's pots are glazed with hand-crafted, lead-free alkaline glazes, colored with earthy metallic oxides.

## Meet Our Host

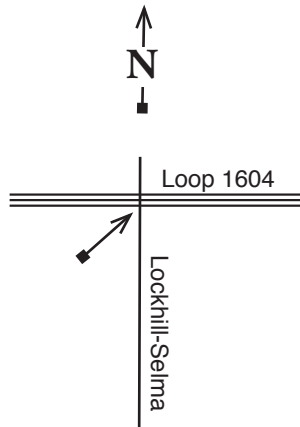
**Nydia Tijerina Darby, MS, PT**
